

2022 GRAND ASSEMBLY DRESS CODE

Masonic Pathways

Rainbow Girls (not grand Family)

- Thursday banquet: White formal
- Friday morning: White formal (**Mother Advisors also**)
- Friday afternoon: Skirt and blouse or dress (no slacks/skorts/shorts)
- Friday night party: 1 or 2-piece bathing suit (no bikini's unless covered by a t-shirt) or casual attire
- Saturday: White formal or official dress, if you are being installed, or skirt and blouse or dress (no slacks, etc.) if not being installed.

Pledges and Adult ladies (not State Officials): Skirt and blouse or dress (no slacks/skorts/shorts) for meetings.

State Officials (Ladies)

- Thursday banquet, Friday morning, Saturday Installation: White formal
- Friday morning: White formal
- Friday & Saturday afternoon business sessions: Skirt and blouse or dress (no slacks/skorts/shorts)
- Friday night party: 1 or 2-piece bathing suit (no bikini's unless covered by a t-shirt) or casual attire

Gentlemen

- Thursday banquet, Friday morning meeting, and Saturday Installation: Suits or tuxedos
- Friday and Saturday afternoon business sessions: Polo shirt is appropriate

Everyone There will be no skorts/shorts, khakis, or jeans at Masonic Pathways (exception: set-up and tear-down crew)

Comfort Inn Hotel

Neat Rainbow appropriate shorts/skorts, khakis (no jeans) with appropriate blouses/tops/shirts/Rainbow t-shirts, for both girls and adults.

- Shorts/skorts must be fingertip length standing up straight with the waistband at the appropriate place. No holes, rips, tears, or letters across backside
- There must not be any extremely low-cut clothes with inappropriate body parts or tummies showing
- Absolutely no sweats, scrubs, yoga, or pajama pants or any other sleepwear in the hallways. That means no jeans except for Friday night activity (no holes in the jeans)
- Flip-flops may be worn in the hallways at the hotel only
- **Dress (formal) shoes must be worn for all rehearsals**

Swimming: Appropriate cover-up over swimsuit and footwear in the hallways at the hotel

Please reinforce that we, both girls and adults, are representing Rainbow and we want to continue to make a good impression on those visiting or seeing us in the hotel, in Mt. Pleasant, or Alma. I am asking that each Mother Advisor and all other adults monitor this dress code. Please gently correct any of our girls, walk them back to their room to change and share with their Mother Advisor. Share this information with your Rainbow Girls and adults and remind them not to abuse this dress code.
